**Description:** A Talavera Faience Ewer Of baluster form with loop handle, painted in blue with a mythical beast in landscape. Faience is a pottery technique where a terracotta body is covered by a glaze which includes tin oxide to give an opaque white ground. This technique was originally developed in the Middle East and often used in Europe to imitate Chinese porcelain before the secret of the method of making porcelain was discovered. From the images this ewer appears to have been made in Talavera, near Madrid in Spain, in the 19th century.
